We accomplish our work through meaningful partnerships and outreach that support our values of environmental stewardship, social equity, and fiscal responsibility.





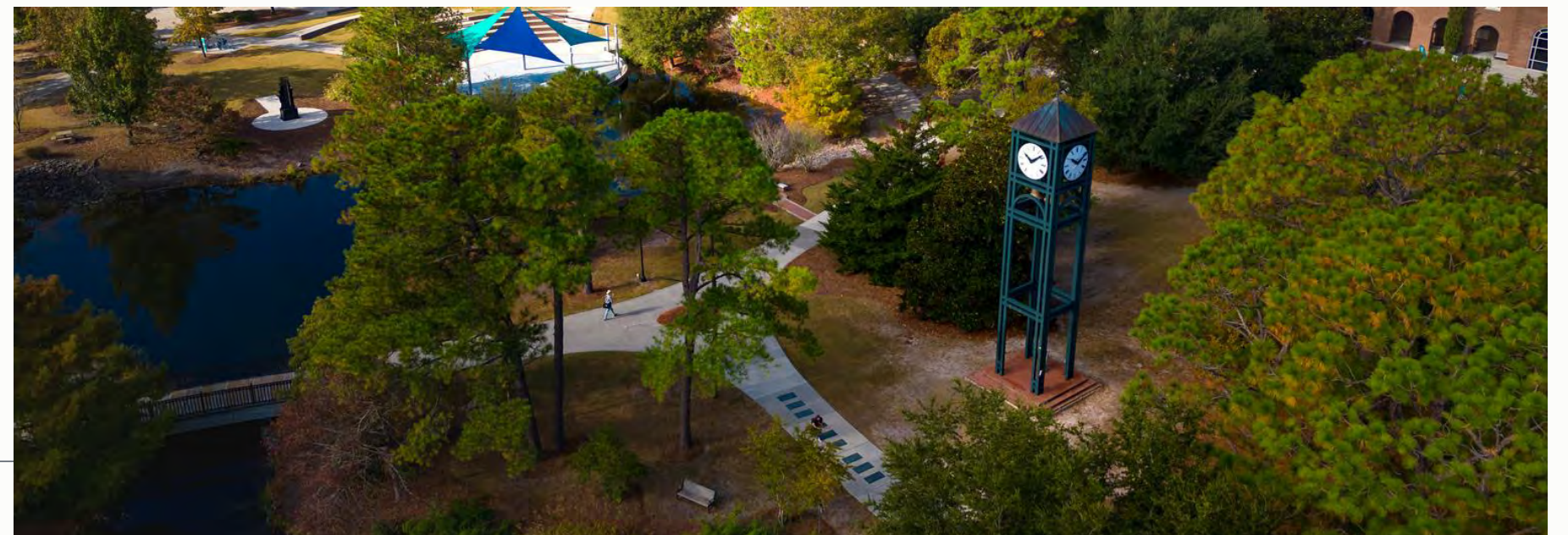
Connecting People to Resources

Water Reuse

UNCW irrigates 90% of campus from storm ponds. We are looking at costs for a pump system for the last 10% to get the whole campus on the water reuse system.

Our projects capture and filter 400,000 gallons of polluted every time it rains!

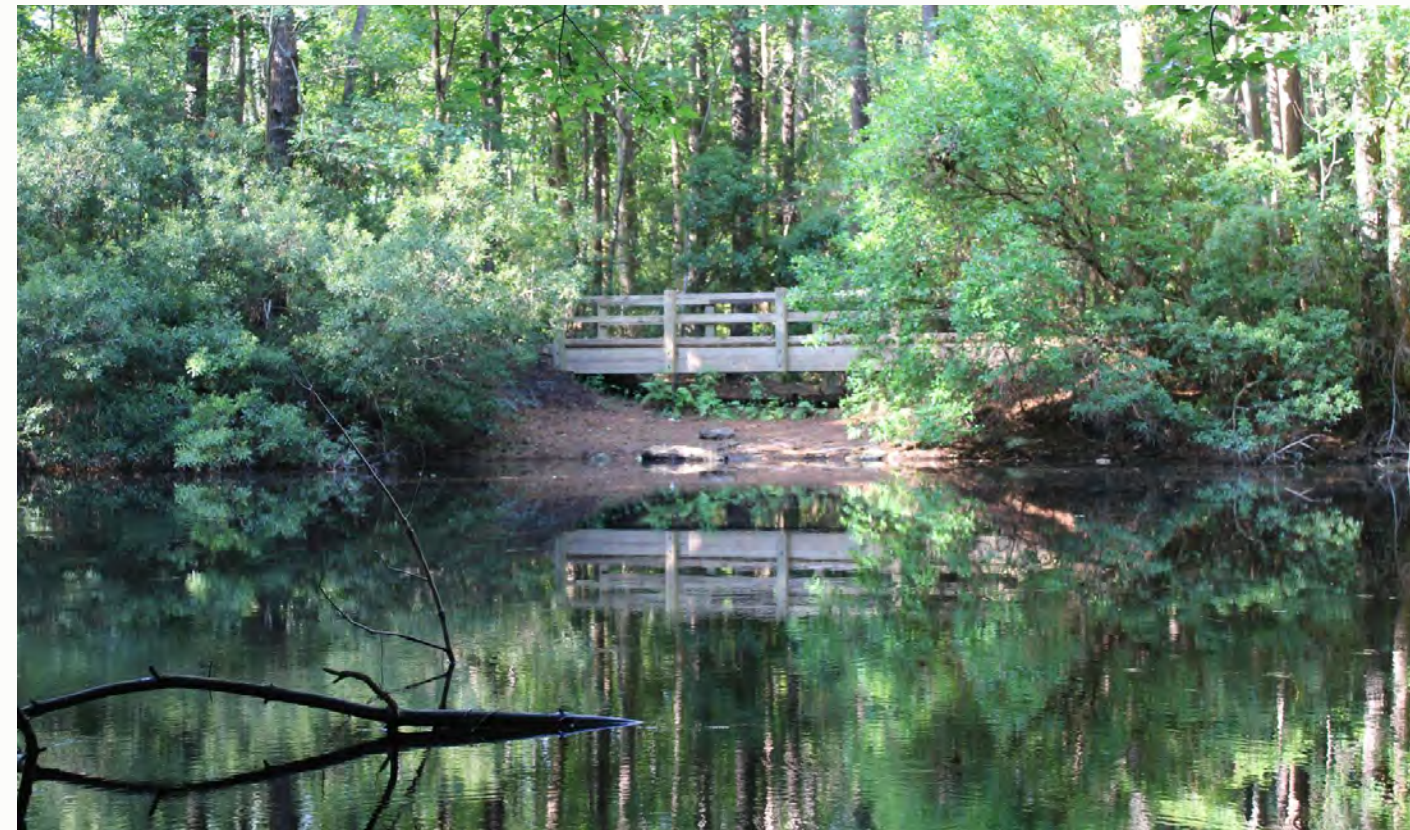




The Wonder of Wander
